First Prize, Work Box.      Second, Pair of Scissors.      Third, Packet of Stationery.

**5.—Men's Hurdle Race, over 16 Years.** (300 yards.)

First Prize, Four Yards Cotton Shirting.      Second, Neck Handkerchief.      Third, Neck Tie.
